The following documents must be submitted in order to receive graduation tickets:

- **Graduate Exit Form** due to the Counseling Center May 31st, by 2:30PM
- **Release of Graduation Tickets Checklist** due on June 8th after school 2:25-3:00PM, June 9th during senior breakfast and after the assembly. Seniors will receive 8 tickets, if they need more they will need to contact other seniors.

Graduation Participation Policy:

In order to participate in Capital High School's Commencement ceremony, Seniors must have met all graduation course requirements. In addition, the class of 2017 must have successfully completed the following: Pass the state exams in English, Math, & Science or designated alternatives; Complete a High School & Beyond Plan and a Senior Exit Interview. Summer School credits may not be planned to establish the student's eligibility to walk in the ceremony. Please note: notification of graduation status and permission to walk at the ceremony will not be granted, until 2nd semester mandatory class credit has been earned. Graduates may not wear non-CHS related items on their cap & gown during the ceremony.
