

Grading for Advanced Leadership

Students earn 10 points a day for being on time, taking initiative and staying on task. If they are not on time, on task or taking initiative, points will be deducted.

Students are also required to effectively manage at least 1 major project throughout the year. Major projects are worth 100 point and students will be allowed to work in pairs or small groups (depending on the project). Students must have permission from Mrs. Elam to take on a major project.
