

Beginning Leadership

Students will earn 10 points a day for being on time, taking initiative and staying on task. If they are not on time, on task or taking initiative, points will be deducted.

Students will be required to earn 100 additional leadership points per semester that may require them to do things outside of the normal school day.

Ways for students to earn additional leadership points include but are not limited to:

- ❖ Active involvement in Homecoming
- ❖ Setting up for events
- ❖ Cleaning up after events
- ❖ Attending CHS events (sports, plays, etc.)
- ❖ Doing Community Service
- ❖ Being a good citizen/helping others
- ❖ Bringing in a guest speaker
- ❖ Going above and beyond to make CHS a better place for everyone (at teachers discretion).

We will also work on character building by actively practicing the following traits which we consider the 8 essentials of leadership:

Patience, Kindness, Humility, Respect, Selflessness, Forgiveness, Honesty, Commitment
